Notice under section 18(1)(a) of the United Nations (Financial Prohibitions, Arms Embargo and Travel Ban) Sanctions Act 2019

Addition of One Entry to the ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida Sanctions List

Notice is hereby given that on **30 March 2026**, the United Nations Security Council Committee pursuant to resolutions **1267 (1999)**, **1989 (2011)** and **2253 (2015)** concerning **ISIL (Da'esh)**, **Al-Qaida and associated individuals, groups, undertakings and entities** has approved the addition of the entry specified below to its ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida Sanctions List of individuals and entities subject to the assets freeze, travel ban and arms embargo set out in paragraph 1 of Security Council resolution 2734 (2024) and adopted under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations.
