### Notice under section 18(1)(a) of the United Nations (Financial Prohibitions, Arms Embargo and Travel Ban) Sanctions Act 2019

#### Amendment of One Entry on the ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida Sanctions List

Notice is hereby given that on **08 July 2026**, the United Nations Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolutions **1267 (1999), 1989 (2011) and 2253 (2015)** concerning ISIL (Da'esh), Al-Qaida and associated individuals, groups, undertakings and entities **enacted the amendments** specified with strikethrough and underline in the entry below on its ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida Sanctions List of individuals and entities subject to the assets freeze, travel ban and arms embargo set out in paragraph 1 of Security Council resolution 2734 (2024), and adopted under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations:
